- Migrated complex software projects from legacy version control solutions, such as Apache Subversion, Perforce, CVS and Microsoft Team Foundation Server, to Git and Atlassian Bitbucket Server, migrating binaries to Sonatype Nexus Repository and managing dependencies, reducing time to market and allowing teams to deliver value quickly.
- Coordinated change management processes and major incidents with other operational teams, such as core services (e.g. load balancer), UNIX, storage, Microsoft SQL Server DBAs and vendors, reducing levels of risk associated with change.
- Upgraded to minor and major versions of Atlassian Bitbucket Server and associated plugins, delivering security and performance improvements aside from new functionality to users.
- Supported production services, troubleshooting incidents and resolution. Monitored internal chat rooms for Bitbucket Server and responded to end-user queries, increasing Git adoption and confidence.
- Developed automated regression testing framework for change management process with Git, Curl, REST and Bash, that created temporary test projects, made various commits locally, pushed each commit and reported the outcome of various rules, which eliminated repetitive manual tasks, delivered value sooner and reduced risk for change management, increasing confidence.
